

**November 5, 2018**  
**COUNCIL MEETING**

The Westbrook City Council met on Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the City Council Room.

Members present: Mayor Dennis Phelps, Jan Johnson, Manda Jorgenson, Chadd Wahl, Kelly Brown

Others present: Carl Conrad, Dan Joel and Alan Wahl

Motion by Wahl and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes from the October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 council meeting. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Police Report was given.

Conrad stated that we are still waiting on the contractor for the Fir sewer project.

Motion by Jorgenson and seconded by Wahl to purchase the Ambulance pagers, radios and training mannequin in the amount of \$11,101.00. The Ambulance will purchase the items on file and will received \$8,850.00 from Heritage healthcare Foundation, \$2,500.00 from a private donation and \$900.00 from fundraising proceeds. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Ambulance and Fire contracts are presented with no changes in rates for another 2 years.

Motion by Jorgenson and seconded by Brown to approve the Exempt Permit for the VFW raffle and bingo. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnson and seconded by Jorgenson to approve the building permit submitted by Terri Hughes for demolition of a house on 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on a request to use a horse as transportation within the city limits. After discussion from city council it was decided that for public safety reasons that we will follow the city code as it states that horses are allowed in town only for parades.

Motion by Jorgenson and seconded by Brown to purchase a hand gun for incoming Chief Hubin. The hand gun is roughly \$600.00 and will need accessories. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Insurance benefits for Mike Hubin will be effective on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 per the employment agreement with personnel committee.

Motion by Johnson and seconded by Wahl to approve bills in the amount of \$72,689.05. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Jorgenson and seconded by Brown to adjourn. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
